

NRA TACTICAL POLICE COMPETITION - COURSE OF FIRE

Course: 4	Course Name: Commercial Alarm
Stage Type: Scenario Based	Start/Stop: Shot Timer / Last Shot
Targets: 12 Paper / 8 Clay	Scoring: TPC - Best 2 Hits on Paper / Clay Target Must Be Broken
Firearms / Rounds Required: Duty Handgun = 24 Rounds / Duty Shotgun = 8 Birdshot Rounds	
Start Position: Handgun is loaded and holstered. Standing with Loaded Shotgun at Shoulder Ready facing Wall 1, left toe touching mark on wall. Body leaning out past Wall 2 with muzzle towards doorway.	
Course Description: You have responded to an alarm sounding at a commercial location. You took a position along an outside wall in order to cover a doorway while waiting for back up. Suddenly you hear what sounds like the action of a handgun being cycled behind you and as you turn you see a suspect begin to point a handgun at you. On the Start Signal, from within the Firing Area engage Clay Threat Targets 1 thru 8 with your shotgun. As you are covering the downed threats you hear screaming for help from within the building and realize you have no additional shotgun ammunition so you decide to secure the shotgun by handcuffing it to a fence pole (Shotgun will be placed Safety ON, Muzzle Down in barrel and handcuff attached to trigger guard). Continue to search the building with your handgun, engaging Threat Targets 9 thru 20 as seen. All walls are cover.
