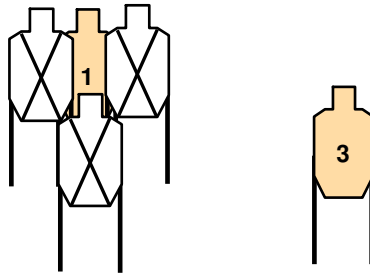


# NRA TACTICAL POLICE COMPETITION - COURSE OF FIRE

<b>Course:</b> 8	<b>Course Name:</b> School Gang Violence
<b>Stage Type:</b> Scenario Based	<b>Start / Stop:</b> Shot Timer / Last Shot – 180 Max Time
<b>Targets:</b> 3 Paper	<b>Scoring:</b> TPC - Best 2 Hits on Paper
<b>Firearms / Rounds Required:</b> Duty Handgun = 6 Rounds	

**Start Position:** Handgun loaded and holstered. Standing facing up-range, toes touching marks indicated holding a cup of coffee in Primary Hand at mouth level.

**Course Description:** You are filling in at the high school for the School Resource Officer while he is attending court. The school has three known gangs and since the beginning of the school year verbal and physical altercations are becoming more frequent, especially altercations between gang members. You are in the hallway outside of the student cafeteria talking to a member of the faculty when you hear a disturbance behind you. Someone yells “Don’t point that gun at me,” a second voice screams, “This is my turf!” and then a shot is fired. On the start signal you pivot and observe three individuals with handguns. Engage Threat Target 1 thru 3 as seen from within the Firing Point.
