The program incorporates competitive based skill and scenario courses of fire to allow you to practice and evaluate your skills using your duty firearms and gear in hypothetical police related encounters and solve the challenges presented according to

your own tactics. Just bring your duty guns, gear, ammunition, and a desire to learn and have fun. Don't have a Patrol Rifle or Patrol Shotgun? We have ones you can use, just bring your own ammunition.

<b>When</b>	Shoot Saturday Sept 19th <b>OR</b> Sunday Sept 20th. Awards and Prize Table Walk will be on Sunday.
<b>What</b>	Tactical Multi-Gun Competitive Based Training Event / 6 Courses of Fire
<b>Firearms</b>	Law Enforcement model Duty Handgun, Shotgun & Patrol Rifle <b>NO Competition Guns!</b> / Remington and FN America Shotguns and AR Patrol Rifles available for use – <u>you provide all ammunition</u>
<b>Divisions</b>	Patrol Division = Iron Sights on all guns & Pump Shotgun / Tactical Division = Rifle can have one optic & Pump or Semi-Automatic Shotgun with iron sights / Maximum Rifle Caliber is 6.8mm
<b>Ammo</b>	Round Count and other info is sent by e-mail to registered shooters 5 to 7 days prior to event.
<b>Gear You Need</b>	Duty Holster & Magazine Pouch / Rifle and Shotgun Gear / For equipment, firearm, and other requirements go to <a href="http://TPC.nra.org">TPC.nra.org</a> and click on "Standards". <b>NO Competition Gear!</b>
<b>Cost</b>	<b>Early Registration = \$45 by Monday August 17<sup>th</sup></b> <b>After Monday August 17<sup>th</sup> = \$ 60</b> <b>Two Member Team Challenge = \$20</b> Shooters <b>MUST</b> be from the same agency. This <u>is not</u> a separate match, individual team member scores are added together to get the team score with plaques awarded to the top three teams. Sign up is available on site as well.
<b>Prizes</b>	Award Plaques for each Division and LE Category / All finishing competitors walk the Guns & Gear prize table / There will also be a firearm raffle drawing during the Awards Ceremony.
