

Course Type: Scenario Based		Start/Stop: Shot Timer / Last Shot – 180 Max Time
Targets: 6 Paper	Scoring: TPC - Best 2 Hits on Paper	
Firearms / Rounds Required: Duty Handgun = 12 Rounds		
Start Position: Loaded Handgun secured in holster. Seated, back against chair back, hands grasping simulated steering wheel at the 10 o'clock and 2 o'clock, legs forward, and feet flat on ground. Legs covered with Ballistic Safety Blanket.		
Course Description: This Course will allow you to test your Handgun skills from within the closed confines of a police cruiser while reacting to an ambush situation. You are on daylight patrol working a low income, high crime rate area. As you come to a stop for a red light you notice a group of 6 to 8 individuals on the corner you suspect are MS13 gang members based on the clothing and tattoos. While scanning left you see one subject step off the curb and start towards your cruiser with a pistol in his hand. You cannot pull forward or backwards because of cars stopped around you. On start Signal, while seated inside the cruiser engage all Threat Targets from within the Firing Area.

Course Material & Supplies

- Course of Fire Kit: RO Radio / Shot Timer with Random & Max Time Functions / Timer Spare Batteries / RO Clipboard / Score Sheets / Completed Score Sheet Folder / Staple Gun & Staples / Pens / Markers / Tan, White & Black Target Pastors
- RO Table & Pop Up Tent for Shelter
- Competitor Equipment Staging Table (if available) - 2
- TPC Targets = 9 (3 for Non-Threats)
- Target Stands = 9
- Target Stand Spikes
- Target Stand Sticks = 18 Minimum / Various Lengths
- Material for simulated US Mail Box = 1
- Simulated Vehicle made of Coroplast, Plywood or other Material = 2
NOTE: Real vehicles should not be used due to possible ricochets
- Simulated Cruiser made of Coroplast, Plywood or other Material = 1
NOTE: If a real cruiser is used it must be a training range vehicle that is allowed to be shot and consider covering the door/arm rest with old ballistic vests.
- Ballistic Safety Blanket or Ballistic Vest to cover legs
- Chair or car seat to simulate cruiser seat
- Simulated Steering wheel
