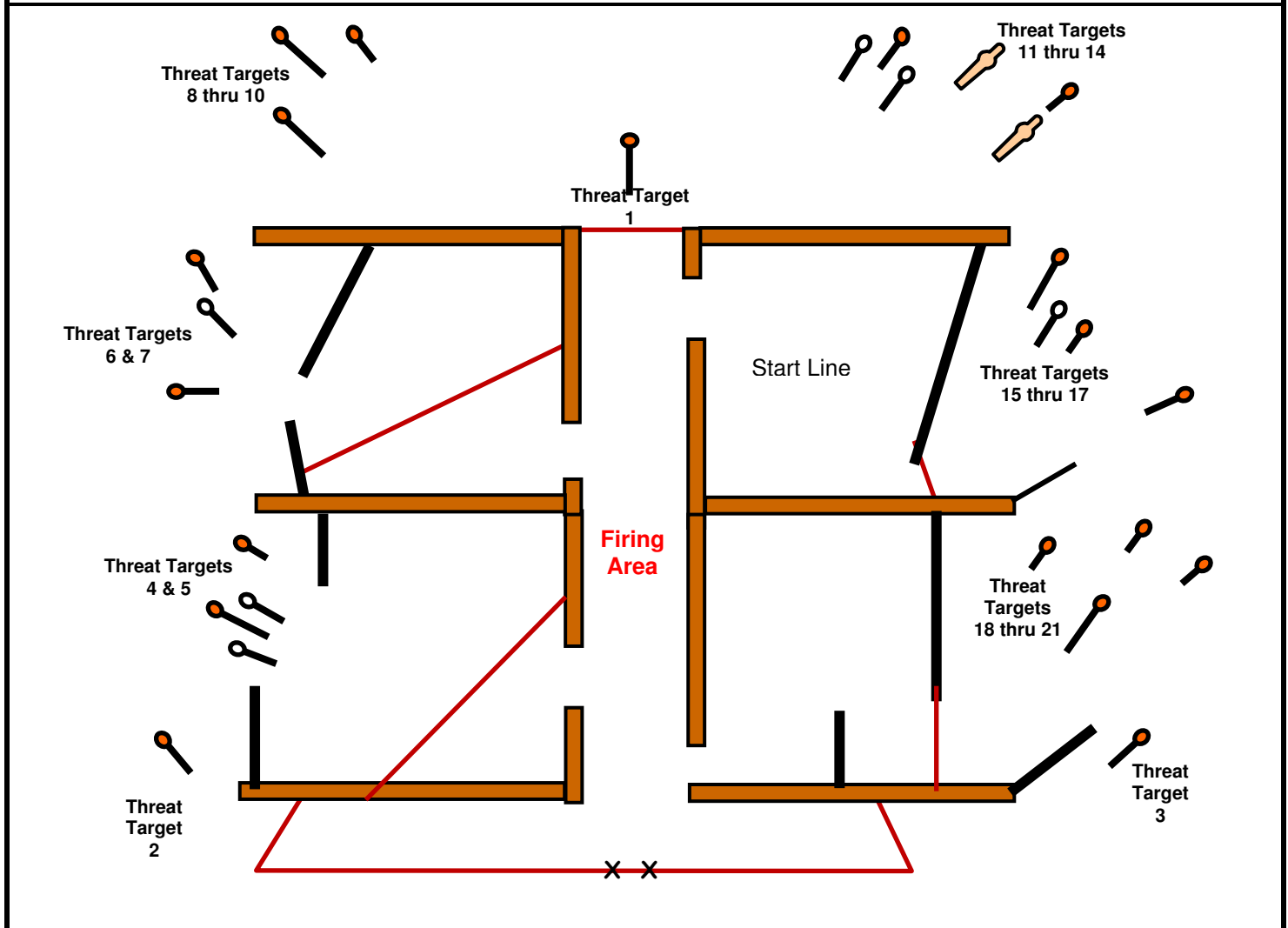

Course: 6	Course Name: Room-to-Room Shotgun	S - 3017
Course Type: Skill Based		Start/Stop: Shot Timer / Last Shot - 180 Max Time
Targets: 19 Clays / 2 Steel		Scoring: Clays Must Break / Steel Must Fall
Firearms / Rounds Required: Duty Shotgun = 21 Birdshot Rounds		
<p>Start Position: Shotgun loaded to Cruiser Safe with 4 rounds (Safety ON, Bolt Locked on Empty Chamber, and Magazine Tube Loaded with 4 Rounds). Standing with Shotgun in Safety Circle Position facing up range with toes on Start Line marks. All ammunition used must be carried in the provided Grab & Go Bag and/or competitors Side Saddle.</p>		
<p>Course Description: On the Start Signal engage Threat Target 1 down hallway. Then move as needed to engage Threat Targets 2 thru 21 from within the Firing Area.</p>		
<p>NOTES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ During any movement while not firing, muzzle must be kept facing down range, or in Safety Circle Position. ◆ For each round fired that did not come from the Grab & Go Bag or Side Saddle = 1 Procedural. ◆ White Clay Birds are No Shoot Targets. Any pellets hitting = No Shoot Target Engagement Penalty. ◆ For this course, walls are Visual Barriers only and do NOT have to be used as Cover or Concealment and moving from cover while empty is allowed.

Course Material & Supplies

- Course of Fire Kit: RO Radio / Shot Timer with Random & Max Time Functions / Timer Spare Batteries / RO Clipboard / Score Sheets / Completed Score Sheet Folder / Staple Gun & Staples / Pens / Markers / Tan, White & Black Target Pastors
- RO Table & Pop Up Tent for Shelter
- Competitor Equipment Staging Table = 2
- Material To Create Firing Area Boundaries
- Material To Make Start Line
- Pepper Popper Steel Target / Handgun-Shotgun Grade = 2
- Clay Bird Stands = 25 plus 2 Spare
- Fence Sections for Walls – Based on Room Size Desired (marked in Brown on COD Sheet)
- Coroplast or Landscape Fabric to make Visual Barrier Walls = 8 (Marked in Black on COF Sheet)
- Paint For Steel
- White Spray Paint to create No Shoot Clay Targets = 5 Cans
- Clay Birds: For 100 Shooters = 1900 Clays / 90 Count Box = 22 Cases
For 120 Shooters = 2280 Clays / 90 Count Box = 26 Cases
For 140 Shooters = 2660 Clays / 90 Count Box = 30 Cases
- Clay Birds for No Shoot Clays = 50
- 1" x 2" x 8' Lumber for Cross Braces, and Firing Area Lines = 15
- 2" x 2" x 8' Lumber to make frames for Visual Barrier Walls and Wall Supports = 35
